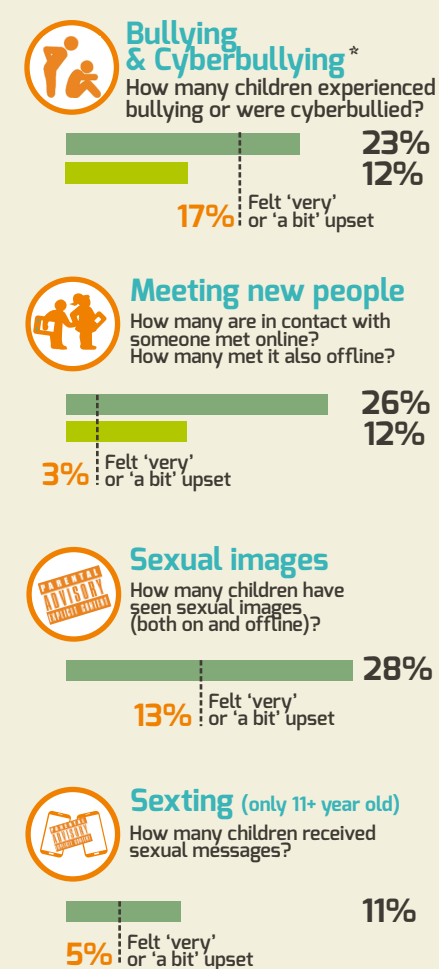


The Net Children Go Mobile project aims to study the changing conditions of internet access and use, and whether it poses greater, fewer or newer risks to children.

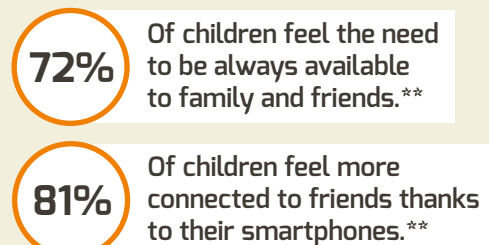
Online risks and harms
